- Ensure 100% of students are meeting their individual learning targets as set down in their Individual Learning Goals (ILG) or Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP)
- Target early literacy support to those students not achieving age or year appropriate benchmarks/standards

Our initiatives include

- Teachers engaging in collaborative work across the cluster through planning and moderation
- Establishment of a High Performing Team to conduct an Inquiry Cycle and standards of evidence to apply and evaluate evidence-based approaches to improving writing
- Explicit teaching on all new literacy concepts
- Implementing the use of Learning Walls in all classrooms
- Implementing writing goals across all classrooms
